Treatment:

Pressure treatment with final retention of 6 pounds per cubic foot.

Preservative:

No. 1 creosote, in accordance with Specification P-1 of the American Wood-Preservers' Association, except that the residue above 335 C. shall be less than 10%.

Penetration:

The preservative should penetrate all the sapwood. It shall pen trate longitudinally not less than one and one-half inches from pinholes, bolt holes and from the ends. The preservative shall not injure the wood. After treatment, crossarms shall be reasonably clean to the touch and should remain so.
